



The Gender Public Advocacy Coalition will release a new report titled *50 under 30: The Gender War on America's Youth*, this June. *50 under 30* is a human rights report that examines gender non-conformity as a factor in fatal hate crimes.

Since 1995, at least 50 youth and young adults have lost their lives – mostly at the hands of peers – because of their gender identity or expression. For the most part, these young people were non-white, gender non-conforming males, and economically disadvantaged.

50 under 30 uncovers a dangerous combination of indifference among mainstream media, police investigators, and legislators that set the stage for such fatal gender-based violence to be carried out.

GenderPAC will use this report to spur decisive action by law enforcement, the media and policymakers to stem this tide of violence and condemn the virulent attacks that are extinguishing the lives of young gender non-conformists in this country.
