New Breakthrough video: Death by Detention:



Breakthrough recently produced a video, "Death by Detention" to shed light on the human rights violations occurring in immigrant detention centers across the United States. Currently 86 immigrants have died in detention and the number is steadily growing. Major press outlets like the *New York Times* and the *Washington Post* have recently reported on the "System of Neglect" or rather, the inhumane, deplorable state of these centers.

As told by her sister June Everett, watch the story of Sandra Kenley, a 52-year-old grandmother, who after living in the U.S. legally for 33 years, was subjected to these very conditions and died in immigration detention.
