## Are you struggling to find affordable meeting space?

This month, **Community Resource Exchange (CRE)**, a management consulting firm which serves over 350 New York City community groups annually, moved into bigger offices. The centerpiece of CRE's new headquarters at 42 Broadway is the new **Community Conference Center (or 'C3')**. This new facility will provide community leaders, nonprofit staff, foundation staff, policymakers, advocates and activists with affordable meeting space for conferences, training workshops, board retreats and a variety of meetings.

Located in lower Manhattan, the **Community Conference Center** is located near many subway lines and the Staten Island Ferry. The C3 features:

- **State-of-the-art integrated presentation technology** including the capacity to provide simultaneous translation
- **One large flexible meeting space** which accommodates up to 80 individuals for receptions, up to 50 for presentations or up to 40 for workshops
- **Three conference rooms** that range in size to accommodate 8 to 18 people
- **Two intimate meeting rooms** ideal for meetings with 2-5 people
- **Three workstations** with computer and phone for training/meeting participants
- **A sunlit and inviting café-style lounge area**

CRE's vision for this C3 facility is that it will serve as a hub for community groups across the city where they can meet, collaborate and access resources they need to strengthen their programs.
