HARLEM UNITED EXPANDS WITH PCDC LOAN

Harlem United Community AIDS Center has completed a \$2.2 million expansion which will allow the provision of primary care within its existing Adult Day Health Care Program at 123-125 West 124th Street in Central Harlem. The expansion was made possible with long-term financing by the Primary Care Development Corporation (PCDC).

"It always broke my heart to turn away homeless persons with AIDS for lack of space," says Patrick McGovern, Executive Director of Harlem United. "Today 20 more persons with AIDS have access to comprehensive healthcare due to PCDC's loan."

Renovations were made to accommodate increasing number of staff and to improve patient circulation, including adding crucial space for education and outreach services and constructing an additional examination room and a dental suite.
